**52%** of Hispanic Americans are independent

41% of Asian Americans are independent

**20%** of Black voters are independent

**27%** of Black men are independent

**28%** of Arab Americans are independent

**27%** of Native Americans are independent

**28%** of multiracial adults are independent

## **National Overview**

**Over 18 million** eligible Latino voters are independent.

**Over 7 million** eligible African American voters are independent.

**Over 6 million** eligible Asian voters are independent.
